### Statement Number 151

#### Full-Time Holder of Public Office - President of the Administrative Appeals Tribunal

#### Background

Subsection 10(1)(s) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995* provides for the Remuneration Tribunal to inquire into, and determine, the remuneration and allowances to be paid, and other entitlements to be granted to persons appointed to certain Full-Time Public Offices.

The Remuneration Tribunal last reviewed remuneration and allowances for the President of the Administrative Appeals Tribunal in November 2003, and issued Statement and Determination Number 141 dated 18 December 2003.

#### Submission

The President of the Administrative Appeals Tribunal made a submission to the Remuneration Tribunal and noted the following two matters.

In December 2003, the Remuneration Tribunal determined that the Chief Magistrate and Magistrates be paid an amount of \$5,000 per annum as a payment in recognition of the requirement to undertake coronial, tribunal and/or presidential duties.

The President is required to undertake duties as a Special Magistrate and Deputy President of the Discrimination, Mental Health, Guardianship and Management of Property, Credit and Tenancy Tribunals.

#### Tribunal Consideration

The Remuneration Tribunal noted that the President may be required, on occasions, to undertake other duties. The Remuneration Tribunal also noted that the remuneration for the President has previously been linked to the level of remuneration for a Magistrate and decided to retain this link.

The Remuneration Tribunal was also advised that there had been a minor error in setting the remuneration for the President in Determination Number 141.

The Remuneration Tribunal determined that the annual remuneration of the President of the Administrative Appeals Tribunal should be corrected for the error in Determination Number 141 and then increased by \$5,000 from 1 November 2003.
