Statement 8 of 2010

Chief Justice of the Supreme Court

Background

Section 10 of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995* authorises the Remuneration Tribunal (the Tribunal) to inquire into, and determine remuneration, allowances and other entitlements to be paid to the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, that are in addition to any remuneration, allowances and entitlements as a resident judge or a judge of the Federal Court.

Remuneration for the Chief Justice is that of a Federal Court Judge, plus an additional allowance. This allowance has previously been determined by the Tribunal as 10% of remuneration.

The Tribunal last reviewed the additional allowance for the Chief Justice in October 2009, and issued Statement and Determination 8 of 2009, dated 7 December 2009, following that review.

The latest inquiry, which sought submissions from interested parties, was notified in the press on 21 August 2010.

Submissions

Written submissions were received and considered by the Tribunal at its meeting on 30 September 2010.

Tribunal Consideration

The Tribunal noted the increases granted to the judiciary by the Commonwealth Remuneration Tribunal since the last review.

The Tribunal decided that there should be no change to the existing arrangement, and determined that the additional allowance for the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court should remain at 10% of remuneration. Accordingly, the allowance for the Chief Justice is increased to \$37,412 per annum.

Determination 8 of 2010

Chief Justice of the Supreme Court

Under sub-sections 10(1) and 10(2) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995*, the Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into the remuneration, allowances and other entitlements to be paid to the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court in respect of that office in addition to any remuneration, allowances and entitlements payable or due to him or her as a resident judge or a Federal Court Judge, and determines as follows:

1. Determination 8 of 2009 dated 7 December 2009 is revoked.
2. An allowance of \$37,412 per annum shall be payable to the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court in addition to the remuneration payable as a Judge of the Federal Court of Australia.
3. This Determination is effective on and from 1 November 2010.
