Background

Section 10(1) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995* provides for the Tribunal to inquire into, and determine, the remuneration and allowances to be paid, and other entitlements to be granted to persons appointed to certain Full-Time Public Offices.

The Chief Minister has referred the office of Commissioner, Emergency Services Authority to the Tribunal under sub-section 10(1)(r) of the Act.

The position heads the new Emergency Services Authority that was created by the *Emergencies Act 2004* on 1 July 2004. The Authority replaced the Emergency Services Bureau.

The statutory positions of Fire Commissioner and Deputy Fire Commissioner were removed by the legislation.

Tribunal Consideration

An independent review of the duties and responsibilities of the position was undertaken by Mercer HR Consulting and the position was assessed at the Executive 3.7 Level.

Tribunal Decision

The Tribunal determined that the position be remunerated at the Executive 3.7 level.

The date of effect is 1 July 2004.

Full-Time Holders of Public Office

Commissioner, Emergency Services Authority

The Tribunal determines as follows:

Pursuant to section 10(1) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995* the Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into the remuneration and allowances to be paid, and other entitlements to be granted to the person holding the Full-Time Public Office of the Commissioner, Emergency Services Authority and determines as follows: -

1. Remuneration at the rate of \$183,964 per annum shall be payable to the Commissioner, Emergency Services Authority;
2. Determination 146 – ‘Full-time Holders of Public Office’ made on 27 April 2004 is varied by inserting Commissioner, Emergency Services Authority and \$183,964 in Columns 1 and 2 respectively in Clause 1 – ‘Remuneration’;
3. Business class travel for the purposes of Clause 4 and 4 star accommodation for the purposes of Clause 6 of Determination Number 110 – ‘Travel allowances for full-time and part-time office holders’; and
4. Schedule A to Determination 110 be amended by inserting ‘Commissioner, Emergency Services Authority’ and deleting ‘Fire Commissioner’ and ‘Deputy Fire Commissioner’.

This Determination shall take effect from 1 July 2004.
