Under section 10(1) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995* I have signed the attached instrument in relation to the Chair and Members on the Priority Investment Program Advisory Panel. I would appreciate it if you would inquire into and determine the remuneration and allowances to be paid and any other entitlements to be granted to these public offices.

The Priority Investment Program Advisory Panel is a non-statutory body established to assess all funding applications under the program and to provide advice to the ACT Government on applications that are considered to meet the requirements for funding. The Priority Investment Program Advisory Panel is an advisory body.

Meetings will occur on an 'as needs' basis dependent on the number of proposals received, to amount to a minimum of four workdays of commitment per annum.

The Advisory Panel will be established to advise on proposals so that funds can be contracted for disbursement to successful projects before 30 June 2023.

I have attached the *Terms of Reference* for the Priority Investment Program Advisory Panel and the completed *Public Office Holder Questionnaire* to assist the Remuneration Tribunal in making a determination.
