Dear Ms Lambert

Under section 10(1) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995*, I have signed the attached instrument in relation to the deputy chair and members of the ACT Ministerial Advisory Council for Veterans and their Families. I would appreciate it if you would inquire into, and determine the remuneration and allowances to be paid and other entitlements to be granted to these public offices.

The Remunerational Tribunal Determination for Part-time Public Office Holders refers to the Ministerial Advisory Council for Veterans and their Families as the Veterans' Advisory Council. As part of this consideration, may I also request the Council name is updated in the next Determination.

The ACT Ministerial Advisory Council for Veterans and their Families is a non-statutory body established to provide strategic advice to the Minister for Veterans and Seniors to support better outcomes for the city's veteran community and to provide a link between the Minister for Veterans and Seniors and veterans and their families.

The Council is an advisory body, without legislated powers, but with the Minister's endorsement to respectfully consult with the community on their behalf and to report to them on relevant current issues and strategic planning; and to recommend policy or legislative changes, or other specific Government action.

It meets on a regular basis, on six occasions per calendar year.

I have attached the Council's Terms of Reference and completed questionnaire to assist the Remuneration Tribunal in making a determination.
