Consumer and Trader Tribunal

Background

Sub-section 10(1)(s) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995* provides for the Tribunal to inquire into, and determine, the remuneration and allowances to be paid, and other entitlements to be granted to a person holding an office or appointment, or a class of offices or appointments, specified in an instrument given to the Tribunal by the Chief Minister.

The Chief Minister has referred the offices of members of the Consumer and Trader Tribunal under sub-section 10(1)(s) of the Act.

Tribunal Consideration

The Tribunal compared the responsibilities of the members to positions on other boards and committees using the Part-Time Holders of Public Office Remuneration Guidelines.

Considering these comparisons and based on the information provided, the Tribunal has determined that the members met the criteria for the Group 3, Level 2 Category ie 'Quasi/Judicial Tribunals, Boards of Inquiry and Management – Bodies/Tribunals'

Tribunal Decision

The Tribunal has set the following rates:

President:	\$645 per diem;
Deputy President:	\$425 per diem;
Members:	\$270 per diem; and
Presiding Members:	\$350 per diem.

The Tribunal has also determined travel entitlements by reference to "All other offices" in Determination Number 110 – Travel Allowances.

The date of effect is 1 November 2003.

The Tribunal determines as follows:

Pursuant to subsection 10(1)(s) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995* the Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into the remuneration and allowances to be paid, and other entitlements to be granted to persons holding public office in the Consumer and Trader Tribunal and determines as follows:-

1. That Attachment 1 of Determination Number 133 made on 18 December 2003 be varied by inserting the following after “*Essential Services Consumer Council*” (Group 3, Level 2):-
