### Accompanying Statement

#### Background

Under section 10 of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995* the Remuneration Tribunal must inquire into and determine the remuneration, allowances and other entitlements for certain full-time public offices. This Determination covers the Clerk of the Legislative Assembly (the Clerk).

The Tribunal's last inquiry into remuneration, allowances and other entitlements for the Clerk was conducted in April 2012. Following the inquiry the Tribunal issued Determination 4 of 2012 in May 2012.

It has come to the Tribunal's attention that the option to elect for cash instead of an employer provided vehicle was incorrectly omitted from the determination issued in May. This determination corrects that oversight.

### **1. Commencement**

1.1 This instrument commences on 1 July 2012.

### **2. Amendment of previous determination**

2.1 Determination 4 of 2012 is amended by inserting the following words at the commencement of clause 4.25 'The Clerk may elect to receive \$16,000 in lieu of the entitlement to a vehicle and \$2,500 in lieu of the entitlement to a parking space, with payments to be made in fortnightly instalments.'
