The issue of interpretation of pro-rata entitlements has arisen in relation to certain terms and conditions of employment.

The Tribunal has determined that the wording of Clause 3 of the Determination should be amended to remove any uncertainty regarding the interpretation.

“Some entitlements, specifically the allowance for parking mentioned above and relocation costs, where the nature of the benefit is such that it is appropriate to maintain the entitlement at the level of a full-time benefit, are not to be pro-rated.”
