ACCOMPANYING STATEMENT

Under section 10 of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995*, the Remuneration Tribunal (Tribunal) is required to inquire into, and determine, the salary, allowances and other entitlements for the ACT Civil and Administrative Tribunal (ACAT) Presidential Members and non-Presidential Members, other than Assessors.

Consideration

The Tribunal discussed and noted the logic of aligning timing of the review of remuneration for all ACAT members with that of the judiciary. The Tribunal also noted that during 2013 ACAT Presidential Members had received two increases, in July and November, to bring them to salary parity with the Magistrates.

The Tribunal determined that from this point forward, review of remuneration for all ACAT members will take place during the annual Spring review in order to align with the review of remuneration for judicial positions.

The Tribunal decided that remuneration for ACAT Presidential and non-Presidential members will remain unchanged at this point and will be considered during the Tribunal's Spring 2014 review.
