Under section 10(1) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995* I have signed the instrument at Attachment 1(A) in relation to the chair and members on the Registration Standards Advisory Board (the RSAB). I would appreciate it if you would inquire into, and determine, the remuneration and allowances to be paid and other entitlements to be granted to these public offices.

The RSAB is a statutory body established to oversee and support the introduction of the Non-government School Registration Standards and advise the Minister for Education and Youth Affairs on applications for the establishment of new non-government schools and the expansion of existing non-government schools.

The RSAB will also advise the Minister on how the regulatory framework should be applied to any ACT non-government schools found to be in serious breach with the Non-government Schools Registration Standards and other elements of the *Education Act 2004* as amended in 2022.

The provisions of the *Education Amendment Act 2022* relating to the establishment of the RSAB commence on 20 December 2022. To ensure there are no delays in remuneration payments to the chair and members of the RSAB, the Remuneration Tribunal's consideration and determination is sought by 21 December 2022.

To assist the Remuneration Tribunal in making a determination I have attached:

- the Remuneration Tribunal Questionnaire Attachment 1(B), and
- RSAB Interim Establishment Procedures and Skills Matrix Attachment 1(C).
