### Statement 2 of 2007

#### Part-Time Holder of Public Office

#### Public Interest Monitor Panel

#### Background

Section 10 of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995* provides for the Tribunal to inquire into, and determine, the remuneration and allowances to be paid, and other entitlements to be granted to persons appointed to certain Part-Time Public Offices.

The Chief Minister has referred the statutory office of Member, Public Interest Monitor Panel for such determination.

#### Tribunal Consideration

The Panel is a statutory body established under the *Terrorism (Extraordinary Temporary Powers) Act 2006*.

The Tribunal compared the responsibilities of the members to positions on other boards, committees and tribunals, as well as individual part-time offices.

#### Tribunal Determination

The Tribunal decided that the Public Interest Monitor Panel should be located in Group 4, Level 1 of the Tribunal's classification criteria, that is, 'Scientific, professional and legal bodies requiring members to be experts in their field, disciplinary boards or boards of appeal'.

The Tribunal has determined that remuneration be set at \$800 per diem for the Member.

The date of effect of the Determination is 6 November 2006, the date of the referral by the Chief Minister.

**The Tribunal determines as follows:**

Pursuant to section 10 of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995* the Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into the remuneration and allowances to be paid, and other entitlements to be granted to the persons holding the Part-Time Public Office of Member of the Public Interest Monitor Panel and determines as follows: -

1. That Attachment 1 of Determination Number 205 made in November 2006 be varied by inserting Member, Public Interest Monitor Panel in Group 4, Level 1: -

2. Economy class travel for domestic travel of less than 4 hours in the air and business class travel for longer domestic travel and international travel, and 4 star accommodation for the purposes of Clause 6 of Determination Number 178 – ‘Travel allowances for full-time and part-time office holders’;

3. Determination Number 178 is also varied by inserting Public Interest Monitor Panel in Schedule under Part-Time Public Offices.
