Sandr-Dear Ms Lambert

The ACT Health System Council (the Council) has been established to provide the Minister for Health and the Minister for Mental Health with strategic advice on health service planning, the commissioning of services and the future direction of the ACT health system. Along with public servants who have been appointed as part of their position, the Minister for Health has appointed independent external members to the Council, for which a determination on remuneration, allowances and other entitlements is required. The ACT Health System Council is a non-statutory advisory body that will meet at least four times per year and more frequently if required.

Under section 10 (1) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act* 1995, I request that you inquire into and determine the remuneration, allowances and other entitlements to be paid or granted to the independent Council members who will hold public office by virtue of their appointment. I have signed the attached Notifiable Instrument in relation to the Chair, Deputy Chair and independent members of the Council. I have also attached the Council's Terms of Reference and a completed Public Officer Holder Questionnaire to assist the Remuneration Tribunal in making its determination.
