Under section 10(1) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995* I have signed the attached instrument in relation to the ACT Multi-Hazard Advisory Council (MHAC) (formerly the ACT Bushfire Council). I would appreciate if you would make the appropriate adjustments required to reflect the change of name of the MHAC and inquire into, and determine the remuneration and allowances to be paid and other entitlements to be granted to these public offices.

The MHAC is a statutory body established under the *Emergencies Act 2004* with the function of advising the Minister for Police and Emergency Services about matters relating to natural hazards. MHAC are currently remunerated under as a level 1 advisory body as outlined under the Review of Remuneration, Allowances and Other Entitlements for Part-Time Public Office Holders Report, March 2017. MHAC meets monthly on the first Wednesday of each month excluding January. A determination is required to enable the MHACs inclusion in the Remuneration Tribunal annual review of remuneration and allowances, scheduled for October 2022.

I have attached the Terms of Reference and complete Questionnaire to assist the Remuneration Tribunal in making a determination.
