Under section 10(1) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995*, I have signed the attached instrument in relation to the deputy chair and members of the ACT Ministerial Advisory Council on Women. I would appreciate it if you would inquire into, and determine the remuneration and allowances to be paid and other entitlements to be granted to these public offices.

The ACT Ministerial Advisory Council on Women is a non-statutory body established to provide strategic advice to the Minister for Women on issues affecting women in the ACT and to provide a link between the Minister for Women and women in the ACT community.

The work of the Council reflects the objectives of the *ACT Women's Plan 2016-26*, with the Council monitoring the progress of achievements towards these objectives through consultation with women in the community and relevant organisations.

The Council is an advisory body, without legislated powers, but with the Minister's endorsement to respectfully consult with the community on their behalf and to report to them on relevant current issues and strategic planning; and to recommend policy or legislative changes, or other specific Government action.

It meets on a regular basis, on six occasions per calendar year.

I have attached the Council's Terms of Reference and completed questionnaire to assist the Remuneration Tribunal in making a determination.
